

Fundraising;

Fundraising is an important part of being a member in a great club like ours. The money we raise as members goes towards keeping our registration as low as possible as well as purchasing important safety items like our long and short track mats. Some of this money will go towards replacing and or purchasing skates that our members can use.



At registration we will still be collecting a fundraising deposit cheque in the amount of \$200.00 to be cashed if you do not fulfil your requirements.

This year our fundraising goal is \$10,000.00 and these funds will be used on new short track half mats. The club is introducing the block system for our fundraising. What this means is each skater will be responsible for fundraising four blocks each, the blocks are valued at a return of \$50.00 per block for a total of \$200.00 per skater.

There will be three fundraising opportunities throughout the season to complete this. We will be selling Mega Lottery just like in previous years. If each skater sold the given amount of two \$100.00 tickets, two \$40.00 tickets and one 50/50 ticket, you would earn two blocks as this has a return to the club of 40%.

There will be another opportunity of selling soups and tea later in the fall as well as Easter Purdy's in the spring.

There will be a chart on the bulletin board that shows each skaters progress as well as emails sent out during the year.

Group Expectations:

Masters, group 1,2,3 and 4 are required to sell 4 blocks.

Learn to skate are required to sell 1 block.
